The Sustainable Development Division (SDD) of the Institute of Industrial & Systems Engineers (IISE) is sponsoring the Sustainable Development Track at the 2019 IISE Annual Conference and Expo. The conference is a forum for exchanging knowledge and discoveries in the industrial and systems engineering research and practitioner communities.

As the chairs of the Sustainable Development Track, we would like to encourage you to contribute to the conference by submitting an abstract. Authors of accepted abstracts will be invited to give a 20-minute presentation of their work in a session. Each session will consist of 4 presentations, for a total of 80 minutes.

Abstracts are welcome for the Sustainable Development Track in the following areas:

Abstract Submission:

- ✓ No more than two abstracts with the same presenting author will be accepted (including invited and contributed talks). There is no limit on the number of abstracts for which an individual can be listed as a co-author.
- ✓ The presenting author of an accepted abstract must register and pay the registration fee to attend the conference. If a presenter does not register by March 8, 2019, the corresponding presentation will be removed from the program, and any submitted paper will not be included in the Conference Proceedings nor be eligible for a Best Track Paper Award.
- ✓ Authors who submit an extended abstract or a paper are expected to review 1-2 abstracts or papers of fellow authors.

Conference Paper:

- ✓ In addition to the traditional abstract and presentation, we strongly encourage you to consider submitting your work as full paper.
- ✓ Similar to previous years, conference papers should contain results that are *significant* and have *archival value* to the industrial and systems engineering research and practitioner community.
- ✓ Conference papers have a six-page limit and will undergo a double-blind peer review process with more rigor relative to the extended abstract.
- ✓ Accepted papers will be copyrighted and indexed in the conference proceedings. Authors of rejected papers will be given the opportunity to resubmit their work as an extended abstract.

Sustainable Development Division

- ✓ There are also opportunities to organize invited sessions, panels, and tutorials. Please contact SDD track chairs with ideas.
- ✓ In addition to research and practitioner presentations, the annual conference offers many opportunities for attendees, including plant tours, networking, nonprofit volunteering, and keynote speakers.
- ✓ Make sure to mark your calendar for the SDD Town Hall meeting, which will be announced as part of conference program. This is a great venue for you to meet SDD members and community.

Important Dates:

- ✓ September 11, 2018 - Abstract submission system opens
- ✓ November 9, 2018 - Abstract submission system closes (no extensions)
- ✓ November 30, 2018 – Authors receive abstract review decision
- ✓ January 18, 2019 - Deadline for submitting required program abstract and optional paper
- ✓ February 19, 2019 - Authors receive Conference Proceedings paper decision
- ✓ March 5, 2019 - Final paper due
- ✓ March 8, 2019 - Presenting author registration due
- ✓ May 18 – 21, 2019 - IISE Annual Conference
